# TINTO REY

## 2025 VERDEJO

### *The Wine*

Verdejo, the iconic Spanish white grape, feels right at home in our warm and rocky Dunnigan Hills vineyard. The 2025 Verdejo opens with a pale straw color and bright, expressive aromatics. The nose reveals stone fruit layered with flinty notes, and a delicate floral touch of gardenia. On the palate, the wine is vibrant and refreshing, with crisp citrus and subtle stone fruit flavors supported by a clear minerality that carries through the finish. Clean, lively, and beautifully balanced, this Verdejo is best served well chilled to highlight its bright character and refreshing acidity.

### *The Story*

Tinto Rey means Red King and is the name of our Spanish centric wine brand. The Dunnigan Hills appellation is uniquely suited for grapes that thrive in a Mediterranean climate. Warm days, gravelly soil, little rainfall; these are ideal conditions for Tempranillo, Tannat, Graciano and Verdejo. The spicy, full-flavored Tinto Rey wines truly showcase the distinctive terroir of our vineyards.

### *The Cellar*

Verdejo is the first grape harvested from our estate, picked in the cool early morning hours by both hand and machine. A portion of the fruit was whole cluster pressed, with 20% of the wine fermented and aged in concrete eggs to enhance its natural minerality and build a creamy texture through gentle lees stirring. The remaining lots were fermented in a combination of neutral oak barrels and stainless-steel tanks. Barrel-fermented portions were then aged for five months in neutral oak to add complexity and roundness. While Verdejo is still a rarity in the United States, it is Spain's top-selling white varietal—and it thrives in the Mediterranean climate of our Dunnigan Hills vineyards.
